### Terms of Reference for Inviting Study Proposal on the Present Status of Livestock Grazing and suggestive plan to phase it out in Tirthan&SainjWildlife Sanctuaries

### 1. Introduction:-

Great Himalayan National Park Conservation Area (GHNPCA) comprises of GHNP (754.40 Km<sup>2</sup>), Sainj Wildlife Sanctuary(90 Km<sup>2</sup>), Tirthan WLS (61 Km<sup>2</sup>) and an Ecozone (265.60 Km<sup>2</sup>) covering in total an area of 1171 Km<sup>2</sup>. GHNPCA (excluding ecozone) is the only Natural World Heritage site in HP inscribed in the year 2014. Proposed study is concentrated in the Tirthan and Sainj Wildlife Sanctuaries which are having an area of 61Km<sup>2</sup> and 90Km<sup>2</sup> respectively. The process of setting a protected area in this region was initiated way back in 1984 and the final notification for Tirthan WLS came on 01-11-1999 and for Sainj WLS on 23-10-1999. Several studies weredone in GHNPCA most importantly by Wildlife Institute of India's research reports of 1999 which comprises of 6 volumes, and the 5<sup>th</sup> volume of which titled as "The Social Environment: Ecotourism and Livestock grazing" focused on livestock grazing. The aim of the present proposed study is to determine the impact of livestock grazing in and around of theTirthan&SainjWLS and the recommendation to phase it out. The study is to be taken up as a requirement of reply to stipulation raised by The World Heritage Committee of UNESCO in the state of conservation report, 2021 "To provide an update on the current status of livestock grazing in Tirthan WLS and plans to phase out grazing, in light of the decision not to recategories the WLS as National Park". Subsequently the Sainj WLS is added as per decision taken in BiodCS.

### 2. Background to the study:-

Livestock rearing is one of the main activities of livelihood in the hilly regions of the country including Himachal Pradesh. In Banjar Sub-division of Kullu district, farming is the backbone of the local economy and also the primary occupation of the inhabitants. Livestock rearing is the second main profession after farming. It is particularly an important source of revenue in the case of high altitude ranges in the Himalayas<sup>1</sup>. In addition, seasonal and migratory pastoralism is commonly practiced in several parts of Himachal Pradesh. Many herding communities continue a long-standing tradition of moving up to alpine pastures (thatches) for the summer and descending to lower reaches in the winter<sup>1</sup>.

Till recent past, Tirthan Sanctuary's high altitude forests and alpine areas have been used for sheep grazing by local villagers as well as migratory graziers. However in Sainj wildlife sanctuary human habitation still exists. The present proposed study is an attempt to determine the detrimental effect of livestock grazing and recommendation to phase it out in and around

Following are the objectives of study:-

- 1. To assess the current status of livestock grazing pressure by domestic graziers in and around the Tirthan&Sainj wildlife sanctuaries.
- 2. To assess the extent of migratory pastoralism in Tirthan&Sainj wildlife Sanctuary.
- 3. To assess the habitat degradation happening in and around of Tirthan&Sainj Wildlife Sanctuaries due to domestic as well as migratory graziers, if any.
- 4. Recommendation and phase out plan to stop grazing in coming years in the sanctuary area.

### 4. Area &Duration of the Study:-

The area of the study is Tirthan&Sainj Wildlife Sanctuaries covering an area of 61 km<sup>2</sup>& 90 km<sup>2</sup>respectively and its periphery in Eco-zone managed by GHNP (average aerial distance 6 Km). Duration of study will befive months

### 5. Proposed Activities:-

- 1. Review of old literature and to find out the villages involved in grazing practice in and around Tirthan&Sainj Wildlife Sanctuaries.
- 2. Field visits to the sanctuary area and to assess the impact of local grazing.
- 3. Study the present status of grazing animals (number of animals, type of animal, productive, unproductive and the grazing pressure on private and forest land) in the eco-zone area nearby to the sanctuaries. More focus on areas surrounding the hamlets/villages (Shugwar, Shakti and Maror) in Sainj WLS.
- 4. Impact of migratory pastoralism in the sanctuaries and to find out number of such graziers, number of animals they take to the sanctuaries and duration of their stay in sanctuaries, if any.
- 5. To find out the impact of grazing on flora and biodiversity in Tirthan wildlife Sanctuary by the local as well as migratory graziers, if any.
- 6. To assess the perspective of local communities on the grazing ban and to study the possible alternatives that could be adopted by them.
- 7. To prepare a phasing out & reduction plan for the grazing pressurein and around the Tirthan&Sainj Wildlife Sanctuaries.

8. Proposal of monetary compensation for Ecosystem services provided by people of this area, if any in consonance with "State policy on Ecosystem Services in HP, 2013".

#### 7. Fund Release Installments:-

- 2.  $2^{nd}$  installment of 30% of the total amount after completion of field work
- 3.  $3^{rd}$  installment of 40% of the total amount after the submission of  $1^{st}$  draft

4. 4<sup>th</sup> installment of 20% of the total amount after the final draft submission along with 4 hard copies of report, soft copies and all the data collected during the study

### 8. Selection Process: -

The process of selection will be QCBS(Quality cum Cost-Based selection). The selection process in detail is mentioned as Annexure – A of this document

### 9. Logistics arrangement:-

The consultant shall be responsible for all the logistical arrangements related to travel, accommodation, working space etc. The Park management shall try to facilitate the provision of accommodation in rest houses wherever possible, at the applicable rates.

### **10.Intellectual Property Rights:-**

All the data, reports and visuals generated by the study shall remain the property of the GHNP administration, however authorship of the researcher shall be acknowledged. No publication of the results of the study shall be made without the prior consent of the GHNP administration.

#### Annexure - A

#### **Selection Process:-**

The selection process will consist of two steps: - Eligibility criteria/Pre-Qualification and Quality cum Cost-Based Selection (QCBS)

- 1) **<u>Pre-Qualification:-</u>** It aims to shortlist proposals from only the genuine reputed consultant institutions/agencies.
  - a. Firm/Bidder/Agency/Institution should have at least five years of research experience in the Plant Science/Social Science/ Animal Science/ Rangeland management/Protected Area Management
  - b. Principal Investigator/Team leader should at least have five research paper in reputed journal in the field of Plant Science/Social Science/ Animal Science/ Rangeland management/Protected Area Management

The supporting documents for pre-qualification should be sealed in an envelope marking on it as Prequalification

2) <u>OCBS: -</u>Ratio of technical and financial bid will be 70% and 30% respectively. The bidder/agency/institution shall submit the complete proposal which consist of Prequalification, Technical Proposal and financial proposal sealed in different envelopes and marked as Pre-qualification, technical bid and financial bid, will be given together in a single envelope addressed to Deputy Conservator of Forests GHNPShamshi. The proposals/bids should be sent by registered post/courier service only

#### 2.1) Technical Proposal:-

i. The total maximum marks for evaluation of Technical Proposal are 100. This score shall be based on an assessment of the Technical Proposal of the Bidder/agency/institution. The Technical Proposal for each Proposal submitted by the Bidder would be assessed through rating of various parameters set out in the table below:-

#### 2.2) Financial Proposal:-

Prices shall be quoted entirely in Indian Rupees (INR) & must be arrived at after including all expenses, rates, applicable taxes and including GST as per the prevailing rates. The methodology for assigning marks for financial proposal is given in detail at point number 4 of Methodology of Evaluation – QCBS.

The envelope containing Financial Proposal should be clearly marked, **"Financial Proposal; Do not Open with Technical Proposal"**.

#### Methodology of Evaluation- Quality cum Cost Based Selection

1. The combined final score of technical and financial bids shall be considered for award of the study. The study shall be awarded to the Agency scoring the highest final weighted score.

- 2. The weightage for the technical proposal and financial proposal in the combined final score will be 70% and 30% respectively.
- 3. The marking scheme for technical proposal will be as per details given in the above table. Technical score  $(S_t)$  shall be out of 100.
- 4. The Financial Proposal shall be evaluated using the following methodology:
  a) The lowest Financial Proposal (F<sub>m</sub>) will be given a financial score (S<sub>f</sub>) of 100 marks. The financial scores (S<sub>f</sub>) of the other Financial Proposals will be determined using the following formula:S<sub>f</sub> = 100 x (F<sub>m</sub>/F)
  b) In which S<sub>f</sub> is the financial score, F<sub>m</sub> is the lowest Financial Proposal (in INR), and F is the Financial Proposal (in INR) under consideration
- 5. Proposals will finally be ranked in accordance with their combined technical  $(S_t)$  and financial  $(S_f)$  scores. The combined total score for the award of study shall be as follow. Combined total score =  $[(S_t \times 0.7) + (S_f \times 0.3)]$
